



Compliance with the REACH Directive (ECHA/PR/19/01)

In regards to the EU's REACH directive and the ECHA candidate list of Substances of Very High Concern for Authorisation (SVHC's) published on October 28, 2008 and amended January 2010, March 2010, December 2010, June 2011, December 2011, June 2013, December 2013, June 2014, and up to plus including the latest revision January 15, 2019 published in accordance to the Article 59 (10), the candidate list of substances of very high concern has been extended.

Therefore, to fulfill our obligation regarding Article 33 (i) of the REACH regulation no. 1907/2006 we are currently checking our products regarding the new substances.

Clippard Instrument Laboratory, Inc. confirms that we do not intentionally add any of the SVHC's to our products. Additionally, to the best of our knowledge, our products do not contain any of the substances of very high concern.

The six newly added SVHC's according to ECHA/PR/19/01 are:

1. 2,2-bis(4'-hydroxyphenyl)-4-methylpentane
2. Benzo [k] fluoranthene
3. Fluoranthene
4. Phenanthrene
5. Pyrene
6. 1,7,7-trimethyl-3-(phenylmethylene)bicyclo[2.2.1]heptan-2-one
