



Compliance with the REACH Directive (ECHA/PR/19/01)

In regards to the EU's REACH directive and the ECHA candidate list of Substances of Very High Concern for Authorisation (SVHC's) published on October 28, 2008 and amended January 2010, March 2010, December 2010, June 2011, December 2011, June 2013, December 2013, June 2014, January 2019 and in addition including the latest revision of July 18, 2019 including the added Category 11 of 250 other products, published January 16, 2020 consisting of electronic and electrical equipment not covered under the other categories; published in accordance to the Article 59 (10), the candidate list of and substances of very high concern has been extended. As of July 18, 2019, the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA) has added 4 new substances of high concern. As of January 16, 2020, Category 11 has been added. As of June 26th, 2020 (4) new substances were added. Therefore, to fulfill our obligation regarding Article 33 (i) of the REACH regulation no. 1907/2006, we are currently checking our products regarding the new substances. (Total 209 substances listed.) This form has been updated to include that Clippard aligns with amends to Annex II to Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 on the registration, evaluation, authorization, and restrictions of chemicals beginning **January 1, 2021**. Our product contains no nanoforms in section 1, no endocrine disruptors in Sections 2, 11, and 12, therefore no new disclosures of ingredients, clarifications on content, and no new subsections. This document has been updated to include the 8 new substances on **July 8, 2021** for a total list of 219 SVHC.

Clippard Instrument Laboratory, Inc. confirms that we do not intentionally add any of the SVHC's to our products. Additionally, to the best of our knowledge and due diligence, our products do not contain any of the substances of very high concern, including the newly added 8 substances as of July 8, 2021.

The four newly added SVHC's according to ECHA July 2019 are:

1. 2-methoxyethyl acetate (article (57c))
2. Tris (4-nonylphenyl, branched and linear) phosphite (TNPP) with $\geq 0.1\%$ w/w of 4-nonylphenol branched and liner (4-NP) (article 57 (f))
3. 2,3,3,3-tetrafluoro-2-(heptafluoro-2-(heptafluoropropoxy) propionic acid, its salts and its acyl halides (covering any of their individual isomers and combinations thereof) (article 57 (f))
4. 4-tert-butylphenol (Article 57 (f))

The four newly added SVHC's according to ECHA June 2020 are:

5. 1-vinylimidazole (Article 57 (c))
6. 2-methylimidazole (Article 57 (c))
7. Dibutylbis (pentane-2,4-dionato-00²) tin (Article 57 (c))
8. Butyl 4-hydroxybenzoate (Butylparaben) (Article 57 (f))
