



## RoHS3 Directive 2015/863 SUPPLIER DECLARATION OF COMPLIANCE

The majority of Clippard's catalog products conform to the Directive (EU) 2015/863 amendment (March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2015) of the RoHS 3 DIRECTIVE 2011/65/EU, RoHS-Recast, Article 4(1) including Category 11 products (category 11 includes all other electronic and electrical equipment not covered under the other categories, (January 16<sup>th</sup>, 2020); with the new four additions of phthalates listed below); that do not contain any of these below-mentioned 10 Hazardous substances above the specified limits located in Annex II in homogeneous materials.

- Cadmium (Cd): 0.01%
- Mercury: 0.1%
- Lead (Pb): 0.1%
- Hexavalent Chromium (Cr6+): 0.1%
- Polybrominated biphenyls (PBB): 0.1%
- Polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE): 0.1%
- Bis(2-Ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP): 0.1% (added 2015)
- Benzyl butyl phthalate (BBP): 0.1% (added 2015)
- Dibutyl phthalate (DBP): 0.1% (added 2015)
- Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP): 0.1% (added 2015)

The information is provided to the best of our knowledge and is based on supplier certifications and our own independent tests. Medical devices for DEHP, BBP, DBP, and DIBP have been exempted from RoHS3 from July 22, 2021 for two years on an extension.

\*Compliant to RoHS2 for bumper component 3821-1 located on specific cylinders.
